



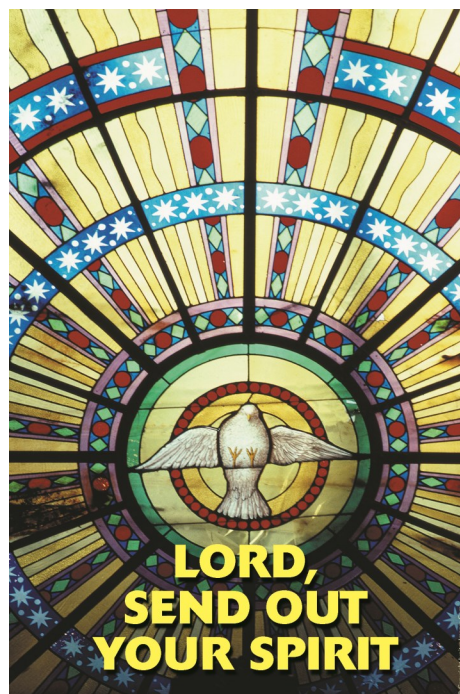

from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.



Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

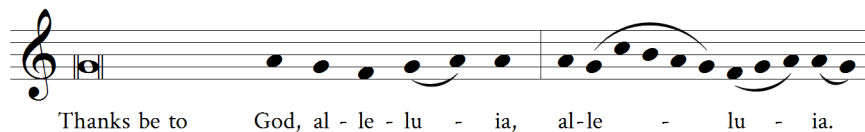
